Fun With Friends: Come and practice finishing a game with a friend, being a good winner, being a good loser and taking turns. Do you remember what your friends like? Do you remember what your friends don't like? Their ideas count too!

Getting Comfortable with Conversation: Get some ideas for starting, maintaining, and ending conversations. We will practice sharing information and our opinions about a variety of topics.
